VINTAGE: 1981

Denomination :

Vin de Pays de l'Hérault.

Harvest dates: *(hand-picked)*

24 September – 5 October 1981 (11 days).

Grape varieties:

- 80% Cabernet Sauvignon.
- 6.3% Merlot.
- 5.6% Tannat.
- 3.9% Syrah.
- 3.2% Malbec.
- 1% rare grape varieties: Nebbiolo, Dolcetto and Barbera.

Climate:

Flowering between 7 and 15 June. Near drought from March to August. Dry wind for 100 days. 7 cm of rain during storm on 15 August. Irregular ripening, grapes stressed through lack of water.

Harvest: hot, clear weather.

Average age of the vines:

9 years.

Yield:

35 to 45 hl/ha.

39.335 bottles.
