- 67% Cabernet Sauvignon.

- 8% Malbec.
- 4% Merlot.
- 4% Cabernet Franc.
- 2% Tannat.
- 1% rare grape varieties: Nebbiolo, Dolcetto and Barbera.

Flowering between 5 and 10 June.
