Denomination :

Vin de Pays de l'Hérault.

Harvest dates: (hand-picked)

17 September – 1 October 1985 (17 days).

Grape varieties:

- 72% Cabernet Sauvignon.
- 7% Syrah.
- 6% Malbec.
- 6% Cabernet Franc.
- 4% Merlot.
- 2% Tannat.
- 1% Pinot noir.
- 2% rare grape varieties: Nebbiolo, Dolcetto and Barbera.

Climate:

Coldest winter since 1956 with serious freezing (-10°C to -15°C) during January and February. Mediocre spring weather leading to late ripening. Flowering from 15 June.

Harvest: Extremely hot and dry, resulting in slight over maturity.

Average age of the vines:

13 years.

Yield:

35 to 45 hl/ha.

Total production:

60.000 bottles, 1.000 magnums, 30 jéroboams and 12 mathuselachs.

13,30% Vol.
