- 65% Cabernet Sauvignon.
- 11% Syrah.
- 10% Malbec.
- 5% Merlot.
- 4% Cabernet Franc.
- 2% Pinot noir.
- 2% Tannat.
- 1% rare grape varieties: Nebbiolo, Dolcetto and Barbera.

Cold, rainy spring until June. Flowering between 15 and 30 June. Very hot in July and August. Storms on 18 August and 23 September.

14 years.
