« The 1987 vintage, a rare and delicious wine »

Denomination :

Vin de Pays de l'Hérault.

Harvest dates: (hand-picked)

10 September – 11 September 1987 (2 days).

Grape varieties:

- 56% Viognier (origin of the vine: Georges Vernay – Condrieu).
- 18% Muscat Petit grain.
- 26% Chardonnay.

Climate :

Frustrating weather all year, unusually heavy rainfall. Flowering between 20 and 30 June.

Average age of the vines:

4 years.

35 hl/ha.

4.400 bottles.
