## VINTAGE: 1990

### Denomination :

Vin de Pays de l'Hérault.

### Harvest dates: *(hand-picked)*

7 September – 9 September 1990 (3 days).

### Grape varieties:

- 47% Viognier (origin of the vine: Georges Vernay – Condrieu).
- 26% Petit Manseng (origin of the vine: Charles Hours – Béarn).
- 16% Chardonnay.
- 11% rare grape varieties: Muscat Petit grain, Bourboulenc, Marsanne, Roussanne, (France). Neherleschol (Israël).

### Climate:

Unusually hot weather even during winter.

A vine called 'Crespy' sprouted a new leaf on 20 January. Very hot weather from 1 May to September. Flowering started in mid-May.

**Harvest:** dry weather but with an east wind, cloudy, no sunshine.

### Average age of the vines:

7 years.

### Yield:

20 hl/ha.

### Total production:

12.000 bottles.

### Alcohol by vol.:

13,15% Vol.

### Total acidity:

3,70.

### Ph:

3,45.
