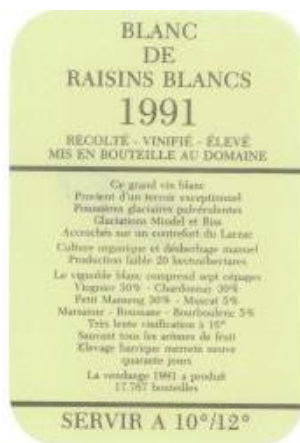


MAS DE DAUMAS GASSAC

VINTAGE: 1991

Denomination :

Vin de Pays de l'Hérault.

Harvest dates: *(hand picked)*

18 September – 19 September 1991 (2 days).

Grape varieties:

- 48% Chardonnay.
- 24% Viognier (origin of the vine: Georges Vernay – Condrieu).
- 22% Petit Manseng (origin of the vine: Charles Hours – Béarn).
- 7% rare grape varieties : Muscat Petit grain, Bourboulenc, Marsanne, Roussanne, (France). Neherleschol (Israël).

Climate:

Very cold winter. Severe frost during night of 20 April destroyed a quarter of the crop.

Harvest: Very hot until the last day of picking. An expected storm never broke. Extremely hot until 25 September with little rain.

Average age of the vines:

8 years.

Yield:

20 hl/ha.

Total production:

17.767 bottles.

12,90% Vol.

3,30.
