In the Gassac valley, 2013 was marked by a severe winter and cool spring, followed by summer heat and then a glorious autumn.

We experienced the latest harvest ever (23 September – 6 October) since the Domaine was founded, and this 36^{th} vintage will be remembered as one of the greatest of all "**Daumas Gassac**" reds.

Distinguished, fresh, elegant, balanced, with unmatched complex aromas, this 2013 is really impressive and thoroughly seductive.

When tasting it, the eye is immediately attracted by the vibrant deep purple colour. On the nose it opens on subtle hints of rich, almost candied, red berries followed by aromas of lightly toasted cocoa. Finally a mouthwatering palate, long, full and very rounded, backed with silky tannins, which together give a sensation of strength and openness, a wine which will truly defy time.

The Gassac valley's amazing terroir and its forty year old vineyard have produced a magnificent 2013 Mas de Daumas Gassac red, a wine already displaying remarkable harmony and finesse.

Wine lovers will be able to put this wine down for 7, 15, 21 years or even longer, when the wine will reveal sumptuous secondary aromas. In its youth, they will also enjoy this excellent vintage, born of a unique terroir, where nature and the environment are truly respected.
