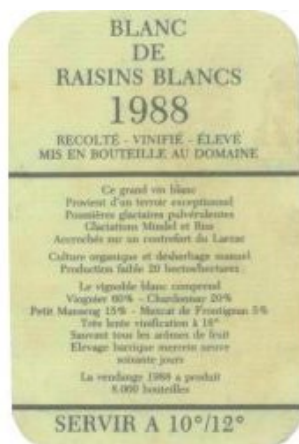


# MAS DE DAUMAS GASSAC

## VINTAGE: 1988

### Denomination :

Vin de Pays de l'Hérault.

### Harvest dates: *(hand-picked)*

10 September – 11 September 1988 (2 days).

### Grape varieties:

- 38% Chardonnay.
- 23% Petit Manseng (origin of the vine: Charles Hours – Béarn).
- 19% Viognier (origin of the vine: Georges Vernay – Condrieu).
- 20% rare grape varieties : Marsanne, Roussanne, Muscat Petit grain (France).

### Climate:

Unusual year with generally gentle or hot weather and regular light rain. Flowering at the end of May.

### Average age of the vines:

5 years.

### Yield:

20 hl/ha.

### Total production:

8.000 bottles.

### Alcohol by vol.:

13,20% Vol.

### Total acidity:

3,10.

### Ph:

3,25.
