## VINTAGE: 1994

### Denomination :

Vin de Pays de l'Hérault.

### Harvest dates: *(hand picked)*

27 August – 30 August 1994 (4 days).

### Grape varieties:

- 33% Chardonnay.
- 32% Viognier (origin of the vine: Georges Vernay – Condrieu).
- 29% Petit Manseng (origin of the vine: Charles Hours – Béarn).
- 6% rare grape varieties : Muscat Petit grain, Bourboulenc, Marsanne, Roussanne, Petit Courbu (France), Neherleschol (Israël), Petite Arvine (Suisse).

### Climate:

Early flowering in May, pleasant spring weather with good showers then a great heat wave hit at just the right time, all adding up to an unusually early harvest.

### Average age of the vines:

22 years.

### Yield:

30 hl/ha.

### Total production:

24.000 bottles.

### Alcohol by vol.:

12,53% Vol.
